Enhanced

Specialty Associations – Ability to tag one specialty to another specialty as associated specialty. (CMS-3584)

Added the ability to list additional specialties as “Associated Specialties.”. When added, the providers of the associated specialties will return in search alongside the providers of the searched specialty.

For example, from the picture below, when the specialty ‘Cardiology’ is searched providers with the specialty “Cardiovascular Disease” will be returned (as will providers for the additional associated specialty.) This feature can alleviate issues with similar\same specialties that are caused by imperfect data. e.g. if a credentialing database feeds the provider directory the specialties OBGYN, Obstetrics and Gynecology and Obstetrics & Gynecology those specialties can now be grouped together via association and return a more relevant search result to your users.

Event Registration – Personal Data Local Storage (CMS-4395)

When registering for an event demographic (name, address) data provided by the user was stored in the browser's local storage to be used in future registrations. This may have been viewed as a privacy issue and has been resolved.

Event Attachments – Attachments size is limited to 5MB. (CMS-4424)

When uploading large attachments, the file size is limited to 5MB. Anything larger than that, the following error message is displayed - **File Upload Limit Exceeded: Please choose a smaller file.**
